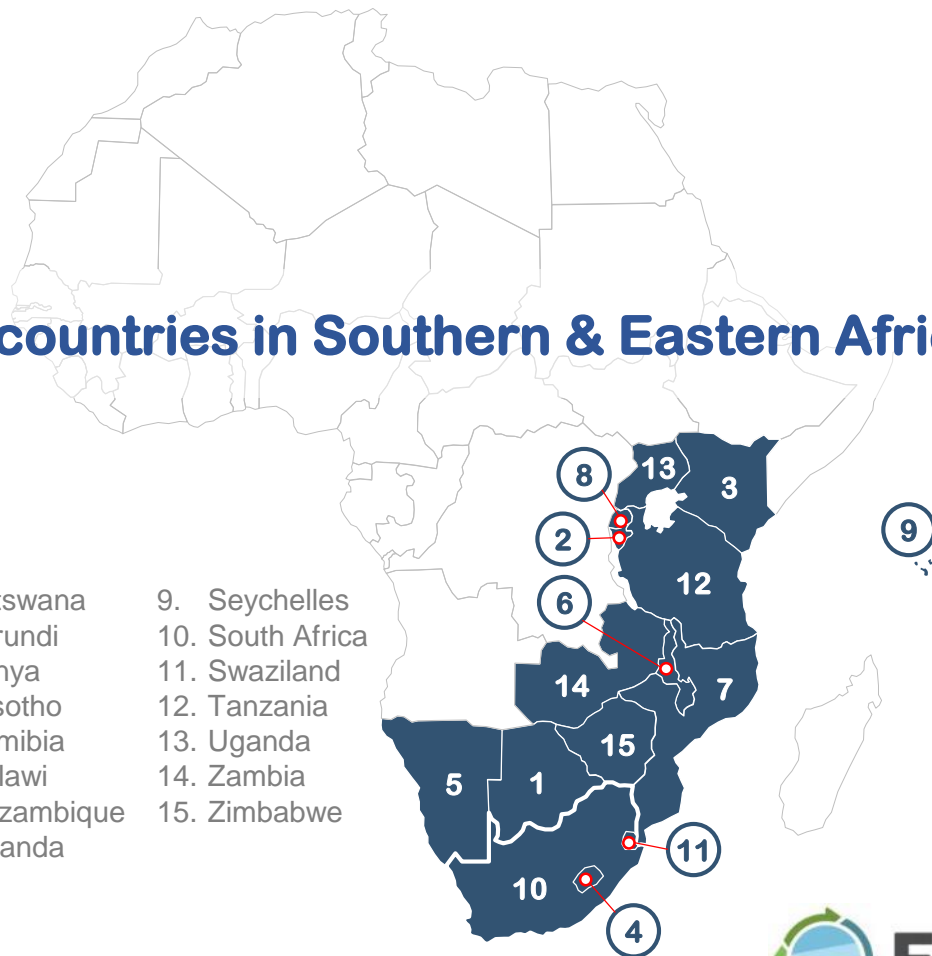


# What is EEP Africa?

- Early stage grant and catalytic financing to innovative clean energy projects, technologies and business models

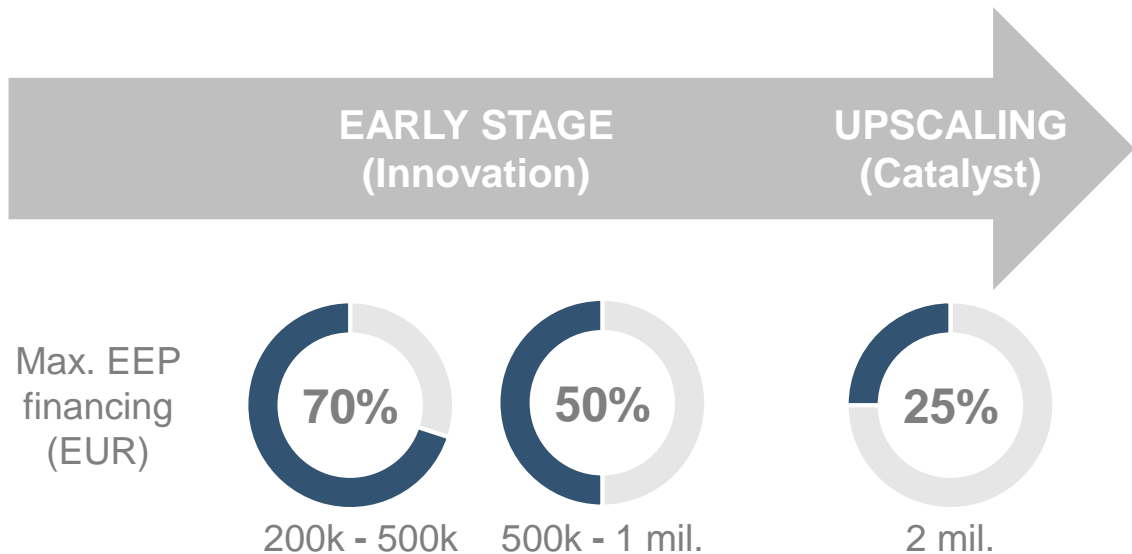
# Financing windows

## EEP Innovation

- Early-stage energy access projects
- EUR 200,000 – 1 million
- Grant, repayable grant or combination
- Co-finance commitment

## EEP Catalyst

- To be piloted in a later stage
- Selected projects from EEP Innovation
- Max EUR 2 million (max. 25% of total new investment)

<b>Funding type?</b>	Grants	Grants & repayable grants
<b>Project stage?</b>	Early-stage (pilots, demos, replication, scale-up)	Early-stage (feasibility, pilots, demos, replication, scale-up)
<b>Sector?</b>	All sectors	Clean energy, energy efficiency
<b>Qualified applicants?</b>	Nordic companies, institutions and organisations in partnership with local organisations	Companies, start-ups, non-profit and social enterprises, research institutes
<b>Application period?</b>	Once a year. Next call August 2018	1-2 calls per year. Ongoing CfP DL 28 June 2018
